Princeses d'Hanteillan is named after the fourth generation of the Blasco family. It is the second wine of Château Hanteillan, made from recently redeveloped plots, thus from the youngest vines. Château d'Hanteillan is located at Cissac. The vineyard is 15 metres above sea level and is planted on Saint-Estèphe limestone massif white marl, clays, Miocene sands.

VINIFICATION

Thermoregulated stainless steel and concrete tanks

AGEING

Maturing in stainless steel vats or wood (French oak)

TASTING NOTES

Red, garnet, with some glints marking slight evolution. The nose is lively, on red fruit, dominated by strawberry and redcurrant. The attack is spherical with solid tannic construction, fruitiness is the watchword on the palate
