**SOIL**

on the surface, the first 30 centimetres are composed of sandy-silt gravel. The subsoil is more subtle with gravelly clays, quartz fractions and some limestone fragments. Fossil-rich limestone is found throughout the subsoil of the 51-hectare vineyard.

## Les Charmes de Liversan 2016

Haut-Médoc

Les Charmes de Liversan is Château Liversan's "young brother". Polignac Family coat of arms are still depicted on the wine label. This cuvée comes from a selection of younger vines, which makes this wine fruitier.

**VINIFICATION**

Thermoregulated stainless steel tanks. Extraction thanks to pumping over. Racking is sometimes carried out at the heart of the fermentation process.

**AGEING**

In stainless steel vats or wood (French oak) for 6 to 9 months

**TASTING NOTES**

Ruby colour for the youngest Liversan, with shaded hues of garnet. Beautiful intensity for simple soil origins, mainly sands.

The nose is a combination of maturing aromas and candied cherry. The palate is succulent and rounded with a fine finish on woody notes, successfully completing the simple construction.
